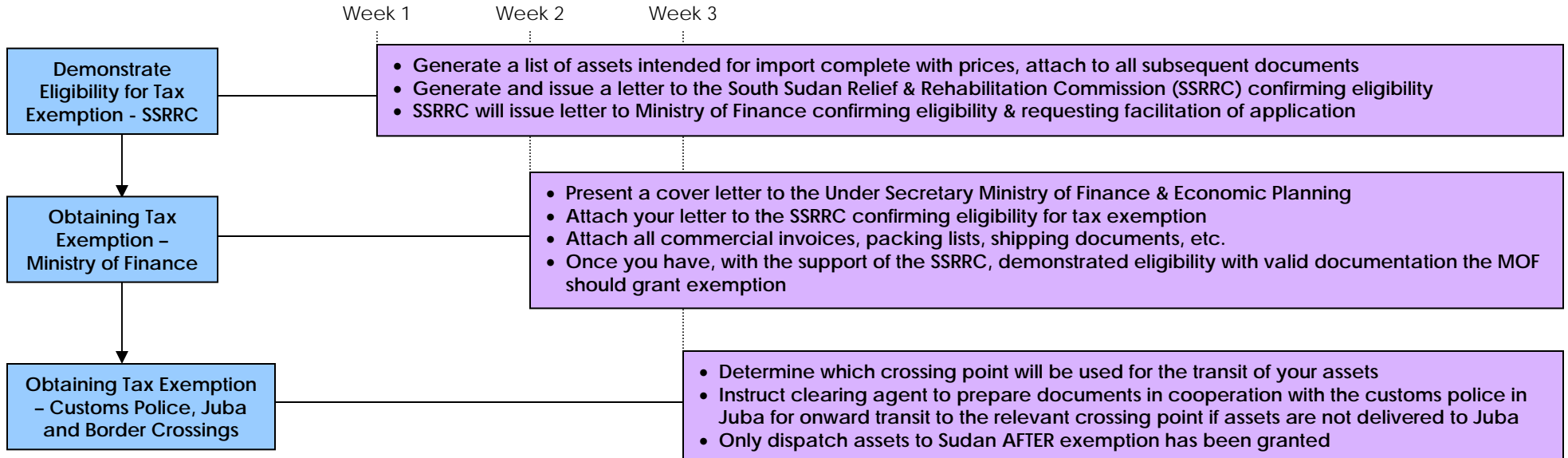

Additional Information: Obtaining Tax Exemption – Customs Clearing Agents

- Section 178. (1) of the Sudanese Customs Act [1986] asserts that customs clearance may be restricted to licensed Customs Clearing Agents (CCAs). This provision is currently in force and the services of CCAs are required under Sudanese law.
- Be prepared to identify and commission a reputable clearing agent to liaise with the customs police; there are many clearing agents co-located at Juba Customs that have excellent working relationships with the customs police. Clearing agents typically charge 1.5 – 2.5 % of the (tax exempt) cost of assets.

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
